1. Present a 1- 2 minute talk about one of your 4-H Projects. The applicant should utilize an object in this presentation.

Your 1-2 minute talk may include:

- A. Introduce your chosen project
 - B. Tell a story about an experience with your project
 - C. Explain what life skill you've attained through this project
 - D. Share some ideas of how or where in our community you could explore and learn more about your chosen project
 - E. Provide ideas of how you could promote 4-H with your chosen project
