RULE TO SELL LIVESTOCK AT THE PRATT COUNTY FAIR

To be eligible to sell livestock at the Pratt County Fair Premium Auction, each 4-H member must attend a minimum of three (3) regularly scheduled 4-H Community Club meetings (this includes all meetings conducted over ZOOM) from October-July AND sell a minimum of five (5) Pratt County Fair Memberships. This will not prevent the participant from entering items in the fair.

REMINDER: ALL 2024 LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

The State 4-H Office has stopped producing the standard livestock ear tag for 4-Hers in the state of Kansas. In light of that, the Pratt County Fair Board has decided to change to the Electronic ID Tag for ALL species. The EID tag will be the tag necessary to show your project at the 2024 Fair. These will be available at each species weigh-in day at a cost of \$3 per tag. Payment will be due upon tagging.


