### Your 1-2 minute talk may include:

- A. Introduce your chosen project
  - B. Tell a story about an experience with your project
  - C. Explain what life skill you've attained through this project
  - D. Share some ideas of how or where in our community you could explore and learn more about your chosen project
  - E. Provide ideas of how you could promote 4-H with your chosen project
2. Interview with a panel of individuals from the community
