Pratt County 4-H Ambassador Policies

Individual Requirements for Application:

- *Must be at least in 7th Grade to apply and participate.
- *Must have been a 4-H Club member for at least two years.
- *Must complete the application and interview process.
- *Must submit a letter of recommendation from one 4-H Organizational Leader (non-family member.)
- *Need to have a willingness to meet people and promote new ideas.
- *Need to be enthusiastic about the youth of Pratt County and the 4-H Program.
- *Need good social skills.
- *Need to be willing to cooperate within a team.

Individual Ambassador Requirements:

- *Ambassador team numbers will be no more than 5% of enrolled 4-H members in the county as of December 1st of current 4-H year. Each year, new Ambassadors will be interviewed and selected in November/December if the quota allows.
- *Attendance to Ambassador meetings is required. Three absences (excused or unexcused) will result in being dismissed from the team. A phone call to one of the advisors is needed for excused absences.
- *Ambassadors should be a positive role model at club and county-wide meetings.
- *Ambassadors are required to enroll in the Leadership project.
- *Participation in 4-H Club Day, 4-H Achievement Night, and the County Fair is required as well as any other events voted on by the team.
- *Ambassador must complete their 4-H Record Book and turn it in to the Extension Office on time.
- *Ambassador must attend State Ambassador Training. (February 24-25, 2017, Rock Springs)

Ambassador Team Responsibilities:

- *Team should present a responsible, enthusiastic, and positive attitude about 4-H.
- *Team may need to submit a budget to 4-H Council for expected expenditures.
- *Team will be in contact with local civic clubs for programs or speaking engagements.
- *Team will promote 4-H during National 4-H Week.
- *Team will work with the Pratt County Fair Board in pre-fair promotions as well as fair activities.
- *Team will send a representative to 4-H Council and present a report.
- *Ambassadors should be available to assist Community Leaders at club meetings and functions.

Ambassador Advisors Responsibilities:

- *Will meet regularly with team to help facilitate activities as well as serve as mentors to the Ambassadors.
- *Will report to the Extension Agents.
