

Interview Process

Interviews will be set up and held in December at the Extension Office.

You will be contacted to set up a time for your interview.

During your interview time each applicant will:

1. Present a 1-2 minute talk about one of your 4-H Projects. The applicant should utilize an object in this presentation.

Your 1-2 minute talk may include:

- A. Introduce your chosen project
- B. Tell a story about an experience with your project
- C. Explain what life skill(s) you have attained through this project
- D. Share some ideas of how or where in our community you could explore and learn more.
- E. Provide ideas of how you could promote 4-H with your chosen project.
- 2. Interview with a panel of individuals from the community
